







COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

POOMSAE: Poomsae competitors must perform the designated poomsae for their specific rank. We will be following the single elimination format. There will be a maximum of 4 competitors per division. Maximum of 2 competitors will perform per round and winner will advance for the final round. Winner will be decided based on accuracy and presentation of the poomsae.

KYOROOGI / SPARRING RULES & DIVISIONS

The current WT & USAT rules will govern this tournament. The organizing committee may modify rules according to the local conditions. May combine or divide weight categories depending the size of the group.

Ages 11 & Under (Color Belts) <u>NO HEAD CONTACT</u>

Sparring competitors ages 11 & younger color belts may not make head contact at any time during the competition. A competitor who executes a technique to the head area will be subject to following actions:

- Any technique attempted to the head area but does not make contact will be given a verbal warning by the referee.
- Any technique which makes any contact with the head area will result in a one-point deduction by the referee (Gamjeom).
- If the competitor cannot continue because of contact to the head area, the attacker will be disqualified. Inability to continue competition because of fright, crying, or loss of will following a legal kick to the body does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker.

Ages 14 & Younger Black Belts, Ages 12 & Above Color Belts LIGHT HEAD CONTACT (JSR)

Competitors are encouraged to attempt kicks to the facial area; however, absolute control must be exercised or the appropriate penalty shall be invoked.

- The competitor who executes a successful kick (light contact without causing injury) shall be awarded 3 points.
- The competitor who executes a successful turning kick (light contact without causing injury) shall be awarded 5 points.
- The competitor who executes a kick to the face or neck, which results in a minor injury shall receive a 1 point deduction. A minor injury is defined as an abrasion or bleeding caused by excessive contact.
- The competitor who executes a kick to the face or neck, which results in the inability of the opponent to continue because of injury shall be disqualified. The jury, referee, and judges after consultation with the tournament physician shall make the determination. (Note: Inability to continue because of fright, crying, or loss of will following a legal kick to the head does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker). However, if the referee and judges feel an injury was due to a malicious attack (with anger or the intent to injure), the attacker will be disqualified.

BLACK BELTS (JUNIORS 15-17), & (SENIORS 18-32) FULL HEAD CONTACT (SR. RULES)

World Class Divisions will be divided according to weight.

**Note: The Tournament Director/Chairman may change/alter weight division if necessary to ensure everyone has matches.

ROUNDS: Best of 3 Rounds. Competitors will have 60 second rounds with a 20 second break. The competitor who wins 2 out of 3 rounds becomes the victor. Every round will have 12 point gap. The Tournament Committee reserve the right to change the duration of rounds as necessary. (World Class divisions will have 90 seconds rounds.)

DIVISION: Competitors will be divided according to their age, weight, belt rank, and specified category group. Every group will have a maximum of 4 competitors (World Class divisions will have no limit of competitors). World Class divisions will strictly follow the respective weight classes. Every effort will be made to pair each competitor with a compatible opponent. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to further divide or combine (within reason) the divisions to give all competitors a fair chance to compete.

**Note: The Tournament Director/Chairman may change the time limit and alter weight division if necessary to ensure fairness and maintain safety.

 - There are risks and dangers associated with participation in martial arts events and activities which could result in bodily injury partial and/or total disability, paralysis and death. a.
 - The social and economic losses and/or damages, which could result from these risks and dangers described above, could be severe. b. ELIGIBILITY	Ages 8+ and all belts are eligible to participate in the Team Demo Competition. All participating members <u>must</u> be registered to compete in Poomsae and/or Kyoroogi competition. To compete in the Team Demo Contest, each team must consist of a minimum of 10 members. Maximum of 10 teams will be the cut off. If 5 or more teams are registered, preliminary round will begin @ 9am.				
COMPETITION RULES	Team Demonstration can be a mixture of Poomsae, Weapons, Board Breaking, Self Defense, and any synchronized movements. There will be NO standing on chairs or tables, and no use of tumbling boards or any similar devices. Due to liability issues, absolutely NO pyrotechnics, fireworks, or flame breaks. Competitors will be cautioned to stage the performance so that flying boards do not endanger officials, spectators or other competitors. There is no limit to the number of Team members, but the team <u>must</u> comply with Contest Area. Demonstration music <u>must</u> be submitted when teams are called upon during the Opening Ceremony. Demonstration music <u>cannot</u> have any offensive or explicit language. Each team must provide its own boards, weapons, etc. for the demonstration.Judging will be based on two criteria: Technical Skills (6 points) – Successful breaking of boards, difficulty of techniques performed, synchronization of team movements, and the completion of the demo within the given time.				
	 Presentation (4 points) – Creativity and complexity, music and choreography, team harmony and Taekwondo spirit. Each team will be given 1 minute set-up time, 7 minutes to complete the performance, and 1 minute clean up time. 1 point deduction from the final score for not completing the demonstration within the given time limits: (a) set-up time, (b) performance time, and (c) clean up time. The winner of this contest will be awarded the Grand Prize of \$1,000 and 2nd Place winner \$500.


